Our two main fundraising events are the wildly popular annual Book Sale (in October) and Wine Tasting (in April) each year.

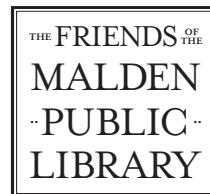
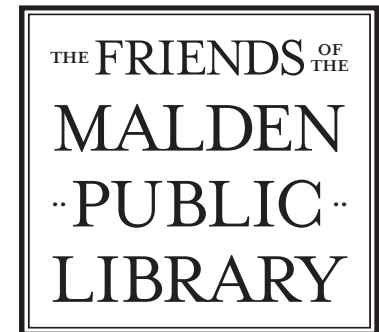
